eTutoring provides online tutoring in a variety of subject areas, including math (developmental to calculus), English, accounting, biology, chemistry, anatomy, physiology, information literacy and research methods. Students can interact in real time with a live tutor or submit questions or material for review and response using:

eQuestions: online question submission with an archive of previously posted questions and answers.

eWriting: online writing lab with an archive of previously submitted papers and revisions

eChat: live communication tool that allows tutors and students to chat, whiteboard, share files and applications, as well as use audio and video tools.

eTutoring provides an extensive menu of tools to help students succeed academically. Students can use:

The Question Queue to submit new questions and review previous postings.

The Online Writing Lab to request help with written assignments. Students submit their work along with a questionnaire about what areas need addressing. All correspondence is archived, including a document revision history, so you can review your progress.

The Online Resource Center where students and tutors can review an extensive resource library full of tips, techniques, and additional links.

Getting Started

- Go to www.eTutoring.org.
- Under “Select Your Consortium or Institution” click on Northeast eTutoring Consortium
- Choose Holyoke Community College from the drop-down menu
- Enter your user name and password. Your user name consists of your first initial, last name and your last three digits of your student ID - all in lowercase. Your password is your date of birth (mmddyy). They are CaSE SenSiTive. Example: If your name is John Smith123 and your date of birth is 01-01-1992, your user name would be: jsmith123 and your password: 010192.
